Becky Plattner called the meeting to order.

Becky Plattner asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the April 10, 2024 session. Stephanie Gooden made a motion to approve. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Becky Plattner asked for a motion to approve a payment schedule. Monte Fenner made a motion to approve. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

County Clerk Brittni Burton presented commission order #6521 in the amount of \$173,657.61 for a cash transfer of payroll, order #6522 in the amount of \$32,308.10 for 941 taxes, and order #6523 in the amount of \$4,104.38 for CERF .7% and elective savings. Monte Fenner made a motion to approve the commission orders as presented. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

County Clerk Brittni Burton presented commission order #6524 as a letter of destruction on behalf of the Building and Grounds Department to destroy an HP printer, order #6525 in the amount of \$28,369.12 for a transfer from 56-00-4750-00 to 55-00-4704-00 due to a receipting error, order #6526 in the amount of \$375,000 for the 1st quarter transfer from 10-35-5018-00 to 35-98-4097-00 to aid in the Jail-Justice Center expenses, order #6527 in the amount of \$15,504 for the 50% match of the Prosecuting Attorney's retirement transferring from 10-35-5098-00 to 44-00-4748-00, and order #6528 in the amount of \$58,924 for the 50% match of the Emergency Management Performance Grant transferring from 10-35-5019-00 to 56-98-4097-00. Stephanie Gooden made a motion to approve the commission orders as presented. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Becky Plattner presented a request to rehire Sharon Sheffer for a part-time position in the Emergency Management Department as an Administrative Assistant due to a recent vacancy. Her rate of pay will be \$20 per hour and her start date was April 22, 2024. Becky Plattner asked for a motion to approve. Monte Fenner made a motion to approve. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Becky Plattner announced that there are two future regular session dates, one in May and one in June, that fall on holidays. The session that would have taken place on Wednesday May 8th is being moved to Thursday May 9th and the session that would have taken place on Wednesday June 19th is being moved to Thursday June 20th.

Sheriff Cindi Mullins reported that the renovation of the Jail-Justice Center is back in progress. The HVAC system is being renovated at the present time. The Jail-Justice Center received an industrial clothes dryer and a full body scanner, both of which are installed and in use. The dryer and scanner were made possible by funding received from the MO Department of Health and Senior Services. She reported that all of the Jail Division staff, as well as two deputies from the Road Division, are fully trained on the body scanner.

County Clerk Brittni Burton presented January, February, and March 2024 additions and abatements. For January, personal property additions totaled \$60,187.93. Personal property abatements totaled \$3,524.85. Real estate additions totaled \$12,201.44. Real estate abatements totaled \$1,377.73. Total January additions were \$72,389.37. Total January abatements were \$4,902.58. For February, personal property additions totaled \$67,892.69. Personal property abatements totaled \$21,488.86. Real estate additions and abatements totaled \$0. For March, personal property additions totaled \$42,384.72. Personal property abatements totaled \$2,647.23. Real estate additions and abatements totaled \$0. Stephanie Gooden made a motion to accept the additions and abatements as presented. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

County Clerk Brittni Burton presented liquor licenses for Applebee's in Marshall/\$303, \$203, Dollar General/\$103, \$103, \$103, Marshall Wine and Spirits in Marshall/\$103, \$28, \$203, Piggly Wiggly in Sweet Springs/\$203, \$103, Pyro City in Marshall/\$103, \$203, Marshall Chamber of Commerce/\$28, Cooper's Oak Winery/Skullsplitter Spirits/\$13, Delaney Vineyard/\$13, Fahrmeier Family Vineyards/\$13, La Paz/\$13, Mi Jalisco/\$13, Red Ox Distillery/\$13, Roaming Spirits/\$13, Six Mile Ordinary/\$13, UpRiver Home and Gifts/\$13, and


Wages Brewing Company/\$13. Monte Fenner made a motion to approve the liquor licenses. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.


County Clerk Brittni Burton presented the 4th quarter report for the Assessor's Office for a \$0 reimbursement from the State due to the Assessor already maxing out for the year. Becky Plattner asked for a motion to approve the report as presented. Monte Fenner made a motion to approve. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.


County Clerk Brittni Burton presented the annual renewal of emergency management agreements for the City of Nelson, City of Miami, and City of Slater. Becky Plattner asked for a motion to approve the agreements as presented. Stephanie Gooden moved to approve. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Stephanie Gooden reported that a Flood Plain permit is being signed for the company doing pipeline work approximately 0.1 of a mile from the intersection of Basil and Elmwood. There is a repair needing to be made on the pipeline that is already there. She also gave preliminary numbers from the Countywide Cleanup that happened on April 13th. She gave a big "thank you" to the community for their participation, to all the volunteers that helped, and to the Saline County Fair Association for the use of the fairgrounds' parking lot. Materials taken in were 360 tires, one 40-yard container of scrap metal, five gaylords of electronics, four gaylords of textiles, and seven containers (270 yards) of waste material. There was also 20 yards of community swap material, which is where someone could leave something that was in good shape and another person could come pick it up. Approximately 113 trucks, 38 tailers, and 28 cars/SUVs for a total of 179 vehicles showed up for the event. Overall, a very successful cleanup. The event was made possible on behalf of the County Commission seeking a grant from Solid Waste Management District Region F, and without the participation of the County and the help of the City of Marshall, it would not be possible.

Becky Plattner asked for a motion to recess to adjourn at noon. Monte Fenner made a motion to recess. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.
